Topic: "All We like Sheep..."

Text: Psalm 79:13

1. The nature of <u>sheep</u>

- a) The pattern of sheep is to <u>wander off</u> (Isaiah53:6)
- b) <u>Easily distracted</u> and <u>easily led astray</u> (Luke 15:3-4)
- c) Good things about sheep...
 - They can learn to follow the True Shepherd
 - They learn to recognize <u>His voice</u> (John 10:27)
 - Once they learn His voice they will <u>not</u> follow a stranger (John 10:4-5)
- 2. The nature of the <u>enemies</u> of the sheep
 - John 10:10;
 - Acts 20:28-30

- 3. The nature of the shepherd
 - a) He knows their <u>names</u> (John 10:3-4)
 - b) Massive searches for the <u>lost ones</u> (Luke 15:3-4)
 - c) Lays down his <u>life</u> for the sheep (Luke 10:14-15)
 - d) He <u>loves</u> the "<u>other</u>" <u>sheep</u> (John 10:15-16; Matthew 9:35-36)
 - e) Jesus the good Shepherd has come to give us <u>abundant life</u> (John 10:10)

4. Life Application

- a) The point of the Christian life is
 "relationship". It means loving our Saviour, following Him, listening to His voice and staying near Him, trusting Him
- b) The Shepherd's job is to lead us. Our job as sheep is to <u>follow</u>.
- c) Being a Christ-follower is not just a crisis event. It is an ongoing relationship with God that results in a <u>new way of living</u>!
