A note from Pastor Owen...

I remember once when someone asked me how they could get closer to God in a personal way. They had accepted Christ as Saviour and Lord, but couldn't seem to make progress in spiritual growth. There are some definite practices that help us get closer to God. The first and most important is a continual and careful 'living in the *Bible'*. As we read and apply the Scriptures to our lives, we create a spiritual environment that draws us close to the Lord and provides for us a buffer from the spirit of the world. The second ingredient is *prayer*. There are two types of prayer. One kind occurs when we talk with our Heavenly father in the midst of ironing, dishwashing, caring for our children, etc. The other occurs when we set aside a specific moment to meet the Lord and pour out our hearts to Him for an extended period of time each day. Thirdly, find a Bible believing church where you have community with other Jesus-followers and pray for one another. Lastly is the matter of talking to other people who don't know the Saviour's love and have not experienced His salvation. We call this witnessing. It always brings a sparkle to our life! Try these four practices and see what happens!
