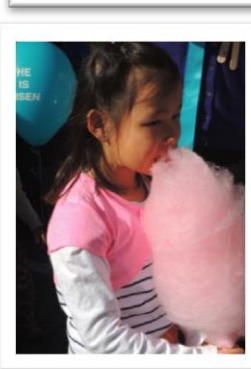
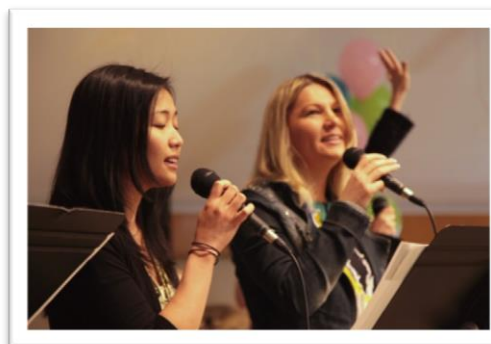


A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

The Lord never makes things complicated for us. Many people get confused about becoming Christians because they assume it must be a really complicated and deeply religious process. Not so! God, in His mercy, has made it amazingly simple. Everything God does is put on a shelf height that you and I can reach. Even a child can understand. Jesus has likened the process of becoming a Christian to that of welcoming a friend into your home. *"Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any man hear my voice and open the door, I will come in"*. (Revelation 3:20) How plain it is...*"If any man hear my voice and open the door"*. How inviting the promise...*"I will come in"*. We can be sure that Christ has entered our hearts and lives there if we have invited Him to do so. Why? Because He promised He would! If you have prayed to ask Jesus to come into your heart, where is He right now? IN YOUR HEART of course! Would Jesus lie about this? Of course not. When anyone asks me how I can be so sure that Christ has come into my life, I simply answer...*"He said He would...and He did"*. Have you asked Him?
