

A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Andrew Murray designed “*four anchors*” (Acts 27:27-29) to help us go through personal trials.

Anchor #1 – Say aloud, “*He brought me here. It is by His will I am in this straight place and in that fact I will rest*”

Anchor #2 – *He will keep me here in His love and give me grace to behave as His child.*

Anchor #3 – *Then He will make the trial a blessing, teaching me the lessons He intends for me to learn.*

Anchor #4 – *In His good time He can bring me out again...how and when He knows – I confess and believe, I am 1) here by God’s appointment 2) in His keeping 3) under His training and 4) for His time.*
