

A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

When people ask me what denomination we are, I usually say “*Christian*”, but then they sometimes want to know what kind of Christian and they want to know if I’m a Baptist...or a Presbyterian...or maybe Salvation Army. I’ve since then concluded that we should all be “*catholic*” in the sense of being universal. We’re not Roman Catholics, but we do belong to the worldwide fellowship of saved believers. The whole church of God should also be “*evangelical*” in the sense of being committed to the good news of the gospel and the authority of scripture. I believe that all churches should be “*liberal*” in the sense of being open-minded, full of grace and generosity and caring for those less fortunate than themselves. Every church in the world should also be “*Pentecostal*” or charismatic in the sense of rejoicing in the gracious gifts (i.e. charismata, which the Holy Spirit lavishes on the Body of Christ, the Church). So what kind of Christian am I? I’m a catholic, evangelical, liberal Pentecostal! This is the title that all of us need to adapt!
