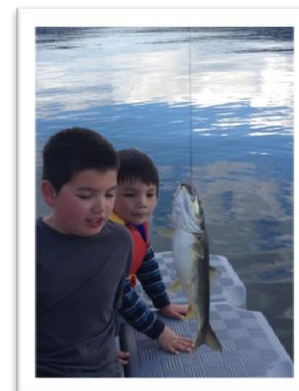


A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Most believers are unaware of the *Geneva Bible* which preceded the *King James translation* by 51 years. It was the primary Bible of 16th Century Protestantism and the Bible used by William Shakespeare, Oliver Cromwell, John Knox, John Donne and John Bunyan, the author of *Pilgrim's Progress*. *The Geneva Bible* was the Bible that was taken on board the *Mayflower* when it sailed to America. On my own personal journey, I can honestly say that I have benefited greatly from every Bible I have read...the *Grade Five Red Gideon New Testament*; the Sunday School "illustrated" *King James* with the closing zipper; the *King James Scofield Study Bible*; the *New American Standard Bible*; the *New International Version* and the *English Standard Version*. Through each of these translations God has spoken to my heart. I have used these Bibles to preach, to memorize and to lead people to Christ. There isn't a "best one".
