A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Every so often I have been asked, "Whom are we to address when we pray? Is it the Father, or is it the Son? Is it scriptural to speak to the Holy Spirit?" According to the historic orthodox Christian view, we are to pray to the Father, through the Son, by the working of the Holy Spirit. The entire trinity is thus involved in our prayers. I've asked the Lord about how I should pray to Him and I'll now tell you the kind of practical insights I've received. John 15:1-17 calls us to abide in Christ. In other words..."to live in Him". Living in Jesus involves dialoguing with Him. Jesus is the working Name of God. He is the image that often appears to me when I look for a vision of the Godhead (See Colossians 1:15). Many times when in need of intimacy and friendship or authority, I address the Lord Jesus. Other times I find myself interceding and saying, "Dear Heavenly Father" or "Father God". On other occasions, such as congregational worship times, or when I start to preach, I often speak to the Holy Spirit and invite Him to manifest His presence. One thing is certain...the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are in complete agreement and unity and all have equal authority. There is no jealousy between them. Since all three are one, the Lord honors our prayer when we talk with Jesus, or the Father or the Holy Spirit. "May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all (2 Corinthians 13:14).
