Back in the days when I was involved in Children's Ministry, we used a little tool called "The Wordless Book" to teach a song. It had four pages and contained not a single word! The first page was black...the next was red...the third was white and the fourth was gold. There was a chorus that we sang while turning the pages. The black page represented our sin and our guilt. Sin had separated us from God. The red page reminded us of the atoning sacrifice and the precious blood of Jesus, shed for all of us. The white page represents my soul as it is washed in Jesus' blood and made white as snow. The gold page reminded us of the streets of gold that we will someday walk with Jesus on in Heaven. I don't imagine it's used anymore, but I'm sure thousands of children were led to lesus by this simple wordless book over the years.
