When people ask me how they can find a good church to attend, I point them to what the late Dr. Francis Schaeffer suggested. First of all, he says there should be an "orthodoxy of doctrine"... that is, it should be Bible-believing in the full sense of that term. Secondly, there should be an "orthodoxy of community". This means that people should care for each other and look after people's needs whenever possible...spiritually, emotionally and physically. The church should be more than just a preaching point or an activity center, but rather a real community where people genuinely care for one another. Thirdly, after these first two points are met, you must find a church that meets your personal needs. Some people like one kind of music...and some another. Some like one kind of preaching and teaching and some another. No perfect church exists, but if you pray for God's guidance you, no doubt, will be led to a great church that is the perfect fit for you and your family. One of the most beautiful things in the world is to find a church that feels like home.
