A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Most of us have "hidden idols" in our lives. These idols are things that we make more important than God. To discover what your own hidden idols are, self-examination is helpful. Ask yourself, "What, next to God is the most important asset or relationship which I'd hate most to face the future without?" Most of us have such a high level of repression and denial with regard to recognizing our idols that we don't realize that whatever we list as second on our list is very likely even more important than God. Our abilities, our work, a relationship, reaching our goals, money or health often become our real security in which we put our faith and energy. We break the power of our idols when we confess them before the Lord. It's hard to confess to God that we really love and trust something more than Him. It's a shocking revelation when a Christian discovers that he/she has made a security idol out of something good, which is less than God. Many of us rebel at this moment and say, "No, I'm not giving this up to you, God. I want it for me - even if it ruins my life". But if we are able to surrender our gods to the Lord's will and confess, "God, I want you more than I want to be a success (or whatever your god is). I want to know you and do your will, trusting you with the outcome of my efforts and my life". When we desire to become God's person more than we want anything else, we are finally free from the power of idols.
