A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

To know the Lord and to serve Him is the greatest privilege a human being can have in life. God gives to every person the ability to serve Him, but it is up to each of us personally to develop our "service-ability". There are three aspects of service-ability...availability, dependability and accountability.

First employ your *AVAILABILITY*. A servant of the Lord is happy to volunteer. He gladly says yes when the Master calls him to do something, even if the task is difficult or tedious. God uses people who tell Him they are available!

Second, employ your *DEPENDABILITY*. Prove to the Lord that you will carry out the Holy Spirit's assignments. Show other people that they can lean on you. Thank God for dependable and faithful workers. This is one of the most critical components of your ability to serve. When God knows He can count on you, He enlarges your ministry.

Thirdly, employ your *ACCOUNTABILITY*. Be ready to answer God and people for the way you are living. Live and serve in such a way that you are never ashamed to give someone a personal report of your day's activities. Every one of us should be under authority. Give key people in your life the right to ask the hard questions. Never be guilty of saying, "My life is nobody's business but my own!" That's not true. As God's servants we hold ourselves accountable and this is pleasing to both God and man.

These are three ways we can develop our ability to serve the Lord.
