A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

The baptism in the Holy Spirit is God's power for ministry. To prepare you for your ministry, let me suggest a couple of steps to receiving the Spirit's power...

- 1) Find someone faithful to God to assist you as you pray. Tell the Lord what you are lacking. Confess your sins and receive His forgiveness. Forgive those who have hurt you in any way. Renounce any involvement with the occult, New Age, horoscopes, etc. Renounce the devil and all his ways and works in your life.
- 2) Ask Jesus to baptize you in the Holy Spirit, to fill you for service. Raise your hands to Him and drink in the Spirit. Be bold enough to begin to speak the language of the Spirit that He gives you.

Remember that the language of the Spirit is given to you whether you speak it or not. Speaking in tongues helps you communicate with God and builds you up the Spirit (See 1 Corinthians 14:2,4) Allow Jesus to be the foundation of your ministry from that day on!
