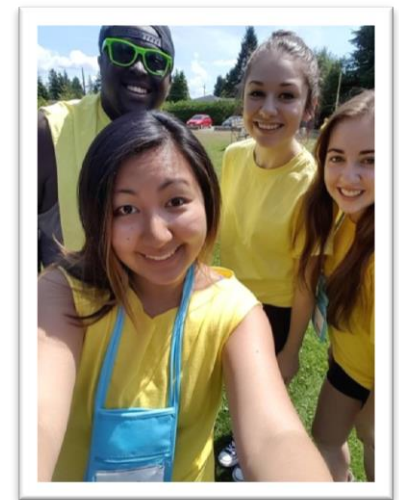


A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Congratulations to Dom Floreano and Lynette Morgan who will be exchanging marriage vows on August 22nd in Blaine.

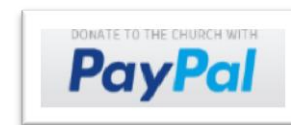
