To live is Christ and to die is more of Christ! In all things Jesus should have the preeminence. Author, Donald Whitney, in his book, *"Simplify Your Spiritual Life*" had it right when he said, "When we go to the Bible we should look primarily for what Jesus says to us in it, for what it tells us about Jesus, for how we are to respond to Jesus, for what we are to do for Jesus". After Jesus appeared to Paul on the Damascus road, Paul declares, "I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me". Paul knew Jesus had laid hold of him for a reason and he was determined to spend the rest of His life finding out what that reason was. Jesus became the reason for everything Paul did and was the center of his life.
