A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

When selecting his material to write the book of Acts, Luke chose to give two chapters to recording the amazing outpouring of the Holy Spirit that took place in Cornelius's home. Acts 10 and 11 mark a turning point in the history of the church. Church history has always had these "flood times" – supernatural surges when God suddenly manifests Himself in unusual ways. The outpouring in Acts 10 and 11 was well beyond Peter's control, but Peter takes time to explain exactly what happened (Acts 11:40). It makes me wonder if I will see a supernatural surge of God's Spirit in my lifetime. Take a moment and read Acts 10 and 11. Exciting things happen when God decides to show up unexpectantly and sovereignly. A "suddenly from heaven" moment could easily occur in our lives. Wouldn't that be an interesting Sunday morning!
