A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

I remember the moment I was sitting in a coffee shop and the proprietor, upon finding out I was a pastor, exclaimed aloud, "How could your Boss allow my 48 year old brother to die from a heart attack and leave a wife and two little kids? What kind of a God is He anyway? Doesn't He have control over those things? What's He doing up there anyway...sleeping? I'm so mad at Him, I can hardly describe my rage!" As I listened guietly to this hurting man, I was reminded again of how much pain and suffering there is in the world. Children are abused; mothers killed by drunk drivers; families torn apart by war; plane crashes; tornadoes; sickness; crime; violence. Waves of bewilderment flood my heart and I cry, "Why, Lord?" Some days it's hard to understand God's goodness when you see suffering and pain. But what brings me back to faith is the thought of God's gracious kindness to me in bringing me to Christ. I looked at this man who lost his brother and said, "You know, I can't explain why things happen as they do, but I do know that if Christ hadn't come into my life, I'm sure *I,* too, would be completely overwhelmed by the despair. Christ's peace in a world of turmoil and the hope of Christ's return to make all wrongs right comfort me in ways I can't ever begin to explain to you. It won't always be the way it is now in a fallen world". The world is going to get worse before it gets better. Only with our hand in His, can we ever be sources of comfort to people shattered by life's pain. But it's never easy and never will be...till the day we feel Christ's loving arms around us.
