
A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

If you are living a life of faith, your life is based on knowing who God is. Having faith in someone is based on a knowledge of His character...knowing that He will do what He has said He will do. Do you realize that the God you serve calls Himself your Father? God is your Father...a good Father...the very best Father in the universe. Good fathers provide for their children. When you committed yourself to Him in making Him your Lord and Saviour, were you aware that then and there he committed Himself to you? God is committed to looking after you and supplying all your needs (Phil. 4:19). Take a moment to read Psalm 37:4-5. God tells us to delight...commit...and trust. The Lord is not a "sugar daddy" who we hit on when we have a need. Nor is He some sort of cosmic bellhop who jumps to attention at our beckoned call. He is the Lord God Almighty. This means we must first delight ourselves in Him. We make Him our first priority. We seek first His will for our lives. We rejoice in who He is and what He is. We surrender our all to Him...holding nothing back. Secondly we "commit our way" to the Lord. Tell Him what you need. Be sure to tell Him why you need Him to supply this particular need. (This will help you separate your needs from your greeds!) Thirdly, "trust in Him and He will do *this".* This is the place where we release our faith. We've asked Him...now we're confident that the Lord will supply, so we say, "Thank you, Lord, that you are looking after me. Thank you for providing for this need. I praise You, Heavenly Father, for your goodness to me and by faith I wait expectantly". He is our faithful God. He will not fail you!
