I love Psalm 90:14 – "Satisfy us in the morning" with your unfailing love that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days". I love it because it gives us the key to know how to "hang loose" throughout each day and not take ourselves too seriously. Most of us are far too tense and uptight. We worry about things we have no control over. We get hurt too often. We seldom laugh enough, especially at ourselves. We carry a load of care and guilt that God never intended us to carry. The scriptures exhort us to "abide in Christ" (John 15:4). This resting in Christ is really another term for "hanging lose". George Mueller liked to say, "It is my first business every morning to make sure *my heart is happy in God".* How right he was! When we're *hanging loose* in the Lord, we can be less dogmatic on the fine points. We can smile more at our mistakes. We can be free to be ourselves and allow others to be who they are too. Are you uptight? Agitated? Upset? Stressed out? Rest in the Lord and hand the problems over to Him. Let Him settle you. Move into that place in Christ of trust and rest. Every morning make yourself happy in your God. Begin to praise Him. Rejoice in His care. Then..."hang loose".
