A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

Someone once said, "You can never do enough for others if you are always surrounded by others". How true! We need time alone with the Lord with only our Bible and our journal. The deep significant things of the Spirit seldom happen at a meeting or at the front of the church. Congregational and celebration times with other members of the Body of Christ are important and necessary, but they must never replace our *"alone*" *times*" with the Saviour. The small groups are vital for our development, but they must never be a substitute for those precious times when just you and Jesus share your hearts together. Solitude is the most crucial of all the spiritual disciplines. Spiritual depth and a Christ-like character only happen when one is alone with the Lord. This devotional practice is a necessity, not a luxury. Do whatever you need to do to make room in your schedule for this to happen. GET ALONE! This is the cry of the hour. Pick the time that is best for you in the day. Mornings, I suspect, are best for most of us, but perhaps not for all. Select a spot in your house that will be your place to meet with the Lord. Bring along your Bible and a notebook to write in. Spend part of your time in scripture reading...another part in prayer...and the last part in meditation, contemplation and surrender to the Lord. These *alone moments* will soon be the most delightful and meaningful moments of your day.
