

A note from Pastor Owen Scott...

I recently talked with a man who believed in God, thought the Bible was true, and was active in his church. He was a fine man, was kind to people and did good wherever he could. He would consider himself a Christian. Before long, though, I realized that this man was not born again. Totally sincere...but not saved. He was a lot like the fellow in Acts 10...Cornelius. The Bible records Cornelius to be devout, God fearing, generous to the poor and respected by the Jews. But he wasn't saved...a religious man and a good man, but he had never trusted Jesus Christ as personal Lord and Saviour. There are a lot of people like Cornelius. They're religious...consider themselves Christians...but have never passed from death unto life. The Lord sent Peter to Cornelius's house to explain God's plan of salvation and he and his family had a conversion experience and were all filled with the Holy Spirit. It's a wonderful reminder that religion can't save us...nor can good works (Eph. 2:8,9). Cornelius had a head experience, but not a heart experience. He knew about the Lord, but he didn't know the Lord personally – so close and yet so far. May I ask you a personal question? Are you born again and are you sure of it? According to Jesus, if you're not a born again Christian, then you're not a Christian at all (John 3:7). That's the only kind there are.
