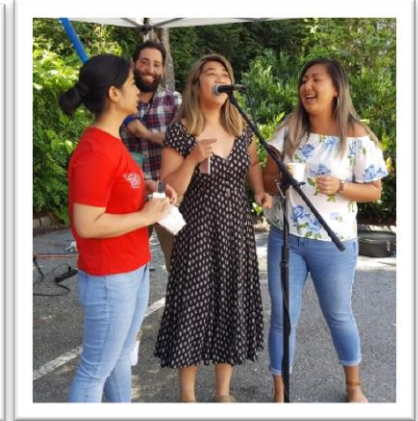

Sunday at Valley Church...

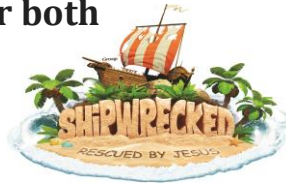
